

Information for Contact Lens Patients

At Bedminster Eye and Laser, we strive to offer the most appropriate contact lenses for your individual needs. Contact lenses are medical devices available by prescription only. As such, contact lens prescriptions must be evaluated yearly in order to maintain a valid prescription. This evaluation is typically not covered by your medical insurance.

We require a comprehensive eye examination prior to fitting contact lenses and we recommend no more than six months between the exam and the contact lens evaluation.

The following fee schedule applies to ALL contact lens wearers:

Your prescription will be finalized and released after examination and follow-up visits as required by your doctor. While we will make every effort to give you satisfactory vision and comfort, we cannot guarantee success in contact lenses. **Contact lens evaluation fees are non-refundable.**

- Exchange of unopened and unmarked boxes
- Complimentary solution starter kit
- Overnight shipping options

Other information to note:

- Contact lens fittings may be done on a separate day from your eye exam.
- Multiple visits are sometimes needed to achieve a proper fit.
- You should always have an updated pair of eyeglasses as a backup option.
- Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied to the fit by a parent or guardian.
- Most contact lens brands are NOT available in colors. Be sure to mention your interest in colors prior to your fitting so you will not need to be refit later.
